²⁷ “Consider how the wild flowers grow. They do not labor or spin. Yet I tell you, not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. ²⁸ If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today, and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, how much more will he clothe you—you of little faith! – Luke 12:27-28

I saw my first crocuses on the Friday before Palm Sunday. The bright yellow and cheerful purple of these two tiny flowers living less than a half an inch from the ground are a message from God assuring us that Resurrection is real. Resurrection happens – spring comes from winter. Resurrection is real – good is born from bad. Resurrection happens – life comes forth from death (be it a dead relationship, a deceased loved one, extinct dreams, or lifeless expectations).

Resurrection happens because God our loving Father raises Jesus Christ from the dead. That means that death never has the final say. Tragedy never triumphs. Ends are never final. Jesus IS alive. Life has the final say. So as spring progresses, consider the flowers that fill God’s world, and be assured that you are Jesus’ beloved, and Jesus is supplying your every need. For if God clothes the flowers with such beauty, think of how much more our risen Jesus Christ is clothing you with His life, clothing you with His love, clothing you with His care, and clothing you with His opportunities to clothe others in the Resurrection love of God.


Good Friday Service

On **Sunday, May 3rd** , Aldo and I will be walking with other folks from WHUMC and lots of other places. Why? For the same reason I have done this for about 15 years: to raise money to combat hunger in my community. For me, it is a Walk of Faith, trusting that God will supply our needs as promised, through our own hard work and through the gifts of people just like you!

Approximately, 80% of what I (and others) raise will go to the **Friendship Service Center of New Britain**, where I am blessed to work (yes, where my ministry and heart are!), 5% will go to End Hunger CT and 15% will support Foodshare, the food bank from which we get much of our food. In Connecticut, more than 128,000 local residents are unable to have enough food on their table, and 50,000 of them are children. Nationwide, the numbers are even greater. This is truly an injustice!

Because of your support last year, we helped make possible for the Friendship Center to serve more than **90,000** meals and snacks to our hungry and sometimes homeless neighbors. Wow!


